<p>Results</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ The skin’s condition normalized or improved in 80% of patients. ■ Most doctors assessed product compatibility as “very good” or “good”, regardless of whether there was concomitant anti-acne medication. ■ The smell, colour, consistency and spreadability were assessed in the majority of cases as “good” or better. ■ More than 82% of patients stated that they wanted to continue using one or several products after the study.
<p>Conclusion</p>	<p>The Eucerin® skincare products for impure, acne-prone skin are valuable tools for the treatment of patients with impure, acne-prone skin and mild forms of acne vulgaris. In addition, the products are excellently suited to use with adjunct anti-acne medication.</p>
